

Residence Hall Resident Information

I Refund Information for Cancellation or Mid-term Withdrawal

1. Full refund of residence hall fees if cancellation is requested before the start date.
2. No refunds for cancellations or changes in withdrawal dates made on or after the move-in start date.

II Facility Information

1. Location: Chonnam National University, Residence Hall Building No.9, 77 Yongbong-ro, Buk-gu, Gwangju

2. Basic Amenities

Inside the Room	Bed (with waterproof mattress cover), desk, drawers, bookshelf, chair, wardrobe
Common Areas	Bathroom (shower), shoe rack, ceiling air conditioning system (no dehumidification), floor heating, refrigerator
Personal preparation:	Basic daily necessities are not provided inside the room (hair dryer, toilet paper, towels, toiletries, etc. are not supplied)

3. Welfare Facilities

4. Garbage Disposal



- Regular trash: Separate collection in outdoor bins in front of the entrance.
- Food waste: Collected in designated food waste bins outside the entrance.

- Connect to WiFi: Dorm
- WiFi Password: 12345678

6. Heating and Cooling Instructions

: The building uses a central supply system; heating and cooling are not provided outside the designated periods.

<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Turn on the power. 2. Press the mode button (lower left) to switch between Heat/Cool. 3. Press the right temperature control to set the temperature higher or lower than the current temperature. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Turn on the power for the corridor heating/cooling control (left-side image). 2. Turn on the power for the room-specific cooling control. 3. Press the MODE button (upper right) to set to ❄️. 4. Press the SET button (second from the left); when the current temperature blinks, press the temperature control button (thermometer shape) to set a lower temperature than the corridor's control.

III Move-in and Move-out Instructions

1. Access Methods

- Building: Access to and from the left and right sides of the door using a guided method
- Room:
 - ① Lightly press the door lock with the palm.
 - ② When the screen activates to allow number entry, enter the instructed door lock password.

※ To change the door lock password, visit "Residence Hall Homepage → Residential Life → Living Guides → PIN Code Door Lock."

※ All entry passwords must never be disclosed to outsiders (such as delivery personnel or parents). We kindly ask for your full cooperation in maintaining strict security.

2. Move-in Information

- Move-in Time: From 10 AM on the move-in day.
- Move-in Procedure: Proceed to the assigned room after the designated move-in time.

3. Move-out Information

- Move-out Time: By 2 PM on the move-out day.
- Move-out Procedure:
 - ① If you changed the door lock password, reset it to the original.
 - ② Seal all garbage (including food from the refrigerator) in the provided black bags and separate them in the external garbage bins.

- ③ Clean the room to the same condition as at move-in (a fine of 30,000 KRW may be imposed if cleaning is unsatisfactory).

IV Rules for Residents

1. Permitted and Prohibited Items

○ Permitted Items

Category	List
Learning and audio devices	Computers, printers, desk lamps, electronic musical instruments, gaming consoles (headphones required for audio devices)
Home appliances	Fans, vacuum cleaners, electric shavers, air purifiers, dehumidifiers, humidifiers
Beauty appliances	Hair dryers, hair stylers, skin care devices, electric shavers, electric hair removal devices, gel nail lamps (straighteners and curlers are exceptions).
Others	Lighters, and electronic devices except for heating appliances.

○ Prohibited Items

Category	List
Heating devices	All electric heating devices (electric blankets, heating mats, water mats, electric cushions, hot packs, electric heaters, etc.)
Cooking appliances	Electric kettles, frying pans, gas burners, hot plates, microwaves, electric cooking pots, toasters, egg boilers, mixers, coffee grinders, coffee machines, and other cooking tools are prohibited
Alcohol	Alcohol and empty alcohol bottles are not allowed in the rooms.
Others	Irons, flammable materials (incense), washing machines, electric scooters, wax warmers, etc

2. Important Notices

- Although the residence hall is accessible 24 hours, refrain from entering between 1:00 AM and 5:00 AM to prevent noise complaints.
- Check the lock (door lock) when going out to prevent theft (you are responsible for any loss).
- If you damage facilities or lose items during your stay, you must compensate for them.

3. Prohibitions

- Changing assigned rooms without permission.
- Smoking and drinking alcohol within the building.
- Providing accommodation to outsiders.
- Engaging in inappropriate behaviors such as assault, gambling, loud disturbances, theft, sexual harassment, etc.
- Not complying with life guidance or engaging in verbal abuse.
